Sub: Phase-II admission to the seats lying vacant in +3 Degree/Autonomous/Self-Financing/Sanskrit (Shastri) under SAMS for the session 2019-20

Madam/Sir,

I am directed to say that the phase-II admission under SAMS for the session 2019-20 for the seats lying vacant in +3 Degree/ Autonomous/ Self-Financing, Shastri colleges (1st Year) shall be ^{held} through online mode as per the following guidelines and timelines.

Procedure

1. An interested candidate can apply online through the website www.samsodisha.gov.in / dheodisha.gov.in against the vacant seat available in the subject.
2. At first, a candidate needs to check College-Subject-Category wise vacancy seats.

3. If candidate has already generated the username and password during Phase-I, then there is no need to create another username and password for Phase-II. The existing username & password can be used for applying the online application.
4. Common Application Form (CAF) and Admission fee will be completely collected through online. No offline payment option will be available. Application fee amount is Rs.275/- for General Category and Rs.175/- for SC&ST Category candidates during phase-II(No fees from PwD & Transgender candidates)
5. The candidate has to pay the full admission fee online once again during Phase-II admission. The final settlement will be done only after completion of total admission period of the session 2019-20.
6. Candidate's passed out examination details and bank information details must be same in Phase-I & Phase-II CAF to get back the differential amount. If there will be any deviation in this information, candidate shall not get back the differential amount i.e. Phase-I and Phase-II admission fees.
7. Merit list will be prepared centrally through SAMS Software & available in Website & College e-Space www.dheodisha.gov.in / www.samsodisha.gov.in.
8. All the points mentioned in Common Prospectus 2019 and letters issued for the session 2019-20 will remain same except the above points.
9. **(NOTE: In the Common Prospectus (CP) for Degree Colleges in the point No-5: Reservation categories for Ex-Serviceman [ESM], Serving Defense Personnel [SDP], Children of Martyrs[CoM], "all stream" mentioned in the first line be read as "each Course". For details, refer College Prospectus available in the dhe website i.e. www.dheodisha.gov.in / www.samsodisha.gov.in.**
